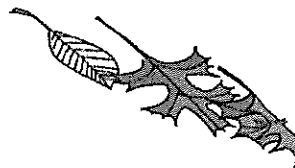

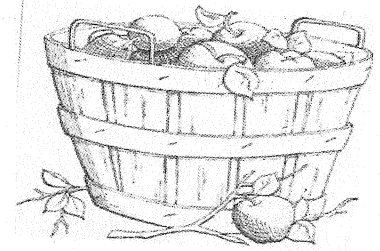



**VERMONT MAPLE COOKIES**

3/4 cup butter  
1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar  
1 egg  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
2-1/4 cups flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
1/2 teaspoon baking soda  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 cup maple syrup  
1/2 cup chopped walnuts  
Walnut halves, or extra chopped walnuts

Cream butter and sugar. Beat in egg and vanilla. Sift together flour, baking powder, soda, and salt, and add to creamed mixture alternately with maple syrup. Blend well and fold in nuts.

Scoop up about 2 tablespoons of dough with a spoon and drop it on an ungreased cookie sheet. Repeat with remaining dough. Top each cookie with a walnut half, or extra chopped walnuts. Bake 8-10 minutes at 400°F.

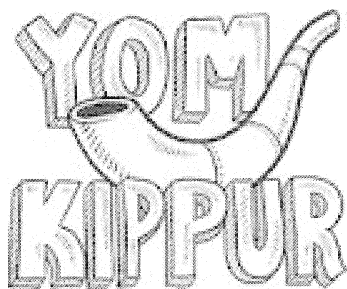

Please make sure prior to making a trip to the Transfer Station that your recyclables are separated. Due to the limited traffic flow, it makes it very difficult for people waiting in line when items have not been sorted. Please make sure all caps and lids are removed from bottles and jars prior to arriving at the Transfer Station. We appreciate your cooperation.

**TEMPLETON TURNPIKE BRIDGE**

The engineering has been completed for the new culvert for the repairs on Templeton Turnpike. We are expecting delivery of this in October and plan to move forward with the repairs as soon as we receive delivery.

**APPLE SQUARES**

1 cup sifted all-purpose flour  
 1 teaspoon baking powder  
 ¼ teaspoon salt  
 ¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon  
 ¼ cup butter or margarine, melted  
 ½ cup packed brown sugar  
 ½ cup white sugar  
 1 egg  
 1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
 ½ cup chopped apple  
 ½ cup finely chopped walnuts  
 2 tablespoons white sugar  
 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon  
 Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease a 9x9 inch pan. Sift together flour, baking powder, salt, and 1/4 teaspoon of cinnamon; set aside.  
 In a large bowl, mix together melted butter, brown sugar, and 1/2 cup of white sugar with a wooden spoon until smooth. Stir in the egg and vanilla. Blend in the flour mixture until just combined, then stir in the apples and walnuts. Spread the mixture evenly into the prepared pan.  
 In a cup or small bowl, stir together the remaining cinnamon and sugar; sprinkle over the top of the bars.  
 Bake for 25 to 30 minutes in preheated oven; finished bars should spring back when lightly touched. Cool in the pan and cut into squares.

**GERMAN APPLE SHEET CAKE**

1 tablespoon butter  
 14 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature  
 1 cup white sugar  
 3 cups all-purpose flour  
 4 teaspoons baking powder  
 lemon, zested and juiced  
 1 pinch salt  
 3 eggs, beaten  
 3 1/4 pounds apples - peeled, cored, and thinly sliced  
 2 tablespoons raisins (optional)  
 Preheat oven to 425 degrees F. Grease a large, rimmed baking sheet with 1 tablespoon butter. Combine 14 tablespoons butter and sugar in a large bowl; beat with an electric mixer until smooth and creamy.  
 Mix flour, baking powder, lemon zest, and salt in a bowl. Alternate adding flour mixture and eggs to the creamed butter mixture. Spread batter onto the prepared baking sheet; dough is very sticky, so use a spatula to spread it onto the tray. Distribute sliced apples evenly on top and drizzle with lemon juice. Sprinkle with raisins.  
 Bake in the preheated oven until set and lightly browned, about 30 minutes.

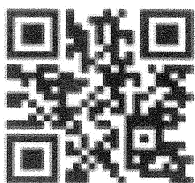

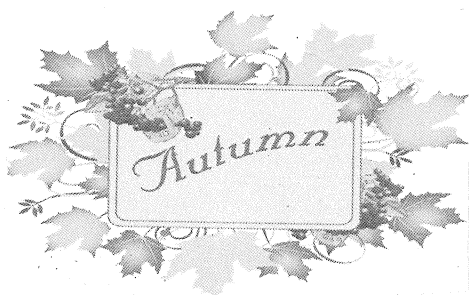


## **OCTOBER EVENTS AT FITZWILLIAM COMMUNITY CHURCH**

The year is winding down. If you need to register your vehicle(s) by the end of the year you can come in any time to do that (no extra charge). This will help you escape the "bad weather" days.

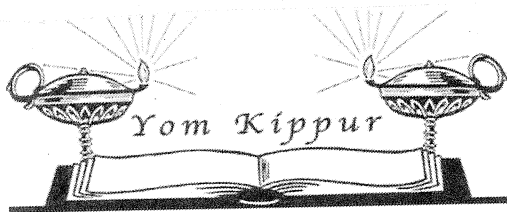

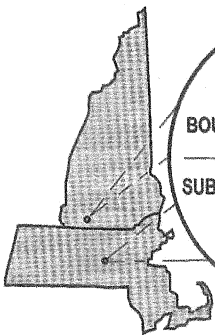



## LAUREL LAKE ASSOCIATION NEWS

The final meeting of the Laurel Lake Association's Board of Directors for 2025 was held on September 26. The Board reviewed its sponsored events as well as the health of the Lake. Our Lake Host program, which checks boats for invasive species, and the AIS committee's monthly reports were also clear.

Association members take these inspections seriously as the primary way to avoid introduction of foreign species that would threaten our pristine lake. We also hope that members of the community, who are not lake dwellers, will be vigilant by protecting the lake by keeping soaps and animals from contaminating the water.

Kat Kelleher from NH LAKES, who spoke at our annual meeting, has visited at least nine homes on Laurel Lake to evaluate runoff from individual homes and to provide guidance on how to prevent further runoff. Her evaluation of each home included written suggestions and her visits are free to anyone who wishes to learn more about how their property can be improved. ### SLICED HAM WITH ROASTED VEGETABLES

6 medium potatoes, peeled and cubed  
 5 medium carrots, sliced  
 1 medium turnip, peeled and cubed  
 1 large onion, cut into thin wedges  
 Cooking spray  
 6 slices (4 to 6 ounces each) fully cooked ham, halved  
 1/4 cup thawed orange juice concentrate  
 2 tablespoons brown sugar  
 1 teaspoon prepared horseradish  
 1 teaspoon grated orange zest  
 Coarsely ground pepper

Grease two 15x10x1-in. baking pans with cooking spray. Add potatoes, carrots, turnip and onion; generously coat with cooking spray. Bake, uncovered, at 425° until tender, 25-30 minutes.

Arrange ham slices over the vegetables. In a bowl, combine concentrate, brown sugar, horseradish and orange zest. Spoon over ham and vegetables. Bake until the ham is heated through, about 10 minutes longer. Sprinkle with pepper.

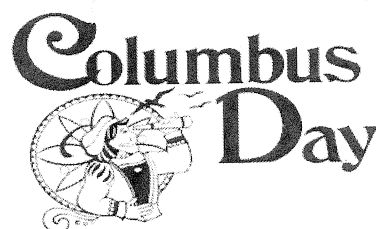

 1/2 teaspoon ground coriander  
 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves  
 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg  
 1 bay leaf  
 3 cups cranberries, washed and picked over
