LAUREL LAKE ASSOCIATION NEWS

January, the beginning of a new year, invites us to re-evaluate our behaviors and commitments, and, to make changes that we hope will improve our lives. This is also a good time to scrutinize our commitment to the world around us. Let's look at Laurel Lake. It is one of the most pristine lakes in New Hampshire. Its water is clear, and supports a variety of wildlife from eagles and loons to fish, turtles, dragon flies, and many, many other species. We also know that many other lakes in New Hampshire are rife with invasive species, bacterial and chemical contamination, smothering milfoil, or combinations of the above.

So, why is Laurel Lake in such good shape? Well, here comes the pitch... The Laurel Lake Association works hard to keep it healthy and clear. We have a Lake Host program that monitors boats before they enter the water making sure that they aren't carrying unwanted, potentially dangerous, vegetation from other water bodies into "our" Lake. The Association's Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Committee has volunteers who monitor the perimeter of the lake each summer month to check for suspicious growths that may have been introduced or started to grow. The Water Testing team regularly checks the Lake's waters for clarity and turbidity and brings samples of water to the DES in Concord for testing.

The Laurel Lake Association's Annual Meeting is held at White's Field in July. Each year a speaker is invited to focus on and educate members on topics of interest about our environment or our past. As you consider your commitments for 2026, whether you live near Laurel Lake or in the town, please consider a membership in the Laurel Lake Association. Become a member by joining on our website

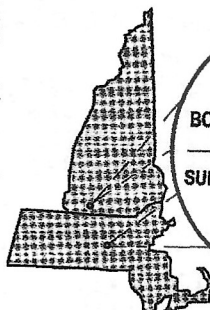

LAUREL LAKE ASSOCIATION NEWS

Have you ever wondered what the fish in Laurel Lake do in the winter? How do they stay alive and keep from freezing or dying without food? We thought you might like to know more about their life in the frozen lake.

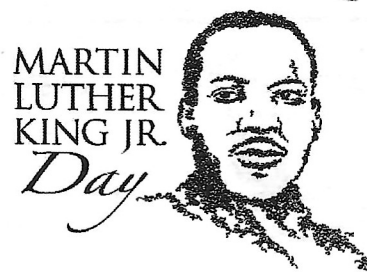
First, ponds or lakes that are more than 10 ft. deep do not usually freeze completely. Laurel lake is about 50ft. deep. There is an area below the ice coverage that does not freeze, although the temperature does drop. Fish head for these deeper areas and adapt to the cold by going into a state of torpor, where they become less active, and need less food while their metabolism drops. Some fish cluster together for warmth, while others may bury themselves in the mud.

Because light penetrates the ice, underwater plants continue the process of photosynthesis, providing food and oxygen for fish. If you would like more information about fish in winter, these are some web-sites you might explore:

CRANBERRY RELISH

TOWN COMMON LIGHTS

We hope you have all noticed the new lights that have been installed on the town common. We were approached by the owner of PLP Composites, who generously donated eight lights. We worked in conjunction with the Common Committee and the Historic District Commission to determine the best placement throughout the common. It was agreed that two additional lights should be installed. The town utilized a trust fund that had been earmarked for use on the town common to purchase these additional two lights.

We are very grateful to PLP Composites for their generosity. We feel these lights fit in perfectly with our historic common and are a wonderful enhancement.

SNOW OBSTRUCTION ON ROADS

Any person who shall put or place, or cause to be put or placed, any snow or ice upon the surface of the traveled portion of any road or town maintained portion of any road for any purpose, except as provided under RSA 236:20, shall be guilty of a violation.

The provisions of this section shall not apply where snow or ice is pushed across the traveled surface of said roadway for the purpose of snow removal from land adjoining said road, as long as said snow or ice is completely removed from the roadway.

Anyone violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and fined not less than \$30.00, and the fine for subsequent offenses shall be \$50.00.

TOWN OF FITZWILLIAM -PUBLIC NOTICE – WARNING

To all car owners and motor vehicle operators in the Town of Fitzwilliam:
Effective November 1, 2025 to April 15, 2026, in accordance with Chapter 41-11 RSA State of New Hampshire, notice is hereby given that all motor vehicles parked on the streets or public ways in the Town of Fitzwilliam between the hours of 12:01 AM and 6:30 AM or that interfere with snow removal operations at any time will be towed away at the owner's risk and expense.

PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT APPLICATION

Municipalities (the Board of Selectmen) may abate taxes "for good cause shown" RSA 76:16. Good cause is generally established by showing an error in the assessment calculation or a disproportionate assessment. Good cause can also be established by showing poverty and inability to pay the tax.

Property owners wishing to apply to the Board of Selectmen for abatement, must submit the Abatement Application to the selectmen's office no later than March 1, 2026.

The time to put in your declaration papers for Local Election is January 21, 2026 thru January 30, 2026. The filing deadline is 5 o'clock on the 30th. **SPICED NUTS**

1 egg white
 1 tablespoon cold water
 1 cup granulated sugar
 1 teaspoon salt
 1/2 teaspoon each cinnamon, cloves, allspice,
 nutmeg, and mace
 2 cups walnut halves (or other nut of preference)
