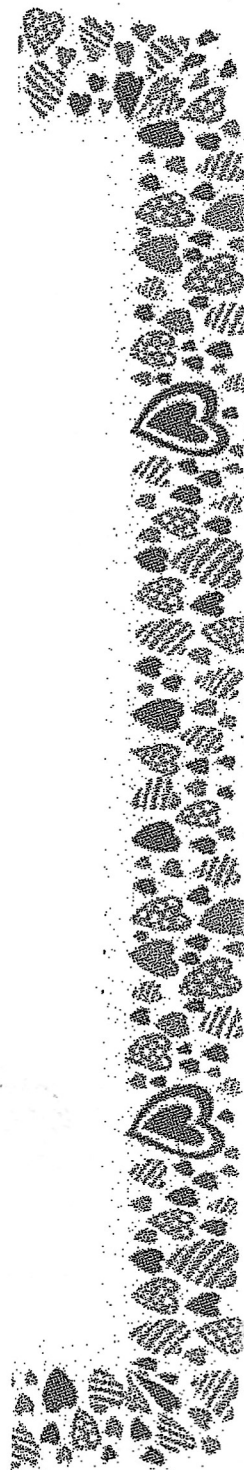

## TOWN CLERK NEWS

Filing for Local Office has passed, now we get ready for the Election and Town Meeting. The Local/MRSD Election will take place on Tuesday, March 11. Polls will be open 11a-7p. The Town Meeting will follow the closing of the polls at 7pm

We are now licensing dogs for the year 2025. All renewals can be completed online if you like, just remember to add 24- to the license number (example: 24-001 would be the license number for 001). The renewal period is from January 1-April 30. There is the month of May to get your license done without late fees. After May 31 there is a \$1.00 per month late fee and around August 15<sup>th</sup> I will start the Civil Forfeiture procedure. (Tentatively issuing around Sept. 1). Please license your dog!

We are also registering BOATS for 2025. You can renew or do New for 2025 now. We do not offer online renewals for boats. Please bring your prior registration when renewing your boat (vehicles too).

The Town Clerk's office will be CLOSED Monday, February 17<sup>th</sup> for President's Day.

You are hereby notified that the 2024 Budget Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 5, 2025 at 7:00 pm in the Lower Meeting Hall of the Town Hall in Fitzwilliam, N.H. Immediately following the Public Hearing, the Budget Committee will meet for a budget work session. In case of inclement weather and this meeting has to be canceled, an additional hearing has been scheduled for Thursday, February 6, 2025 at 7:00pm. ### **APPLICATIONS FOR CURRENT USE, VETERANS CREDIT, ELDERLY AND DISABLED, BLIND EXEMPTION**

**The deadline to submit applications for Current Use and all credits and exemptions is April 15<sup>th</sup>. The deadline for the Elderly or Disabled Tax Deferral is March 1<sup>st</sup>.**

There are income and asset criteria for both the disabled and elderly exemptions as follows:

- Total income, including social security can't exceed \$25,000 per year for a single person and \$35,000 for a married couple. Total assets, excluding your residence and 3 acres of land can't exceed \$60,000.
- A person applying for the disabled exemption must have a letter from social security showing that they are 100% disabled and been a resident of the State of New Hampshire for at least 5 consecutive years as of April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- A person applying for the elderly exemption must be at least age 65 by April 15<sup>th</sup> and been a resident of the State of New Hampshire for 3 consecutive years.

A person applying for the veteran's credit must have been a resident of the State of New Hampshire for a least one year as of April 1<sup>st</sup>. If you have any questions regarding any of these applications, please contact the selectmen's office.

### **ARPA Funds**

The selectmen have completed the expenditure of ARPA funds. We feel that we have been judicious and prudent with these "build back better funds". These funds were used for many maintenance projects on town buildings. Some of the larger projects include:

- \$20,795 Town Hall Plaster Repair
- \$22,700 Paint town hall
- \$24,963 Street Lights changing to LED
- \$20,390 Fire Radios
- \$18,890 Library Roof
- \$9,914 Fire Gear
- \$17,098 Police Radios
- \$10,000 Library building
- \$3,500 Voting Machine
- \$10,000 Repairs to Town Hall steps

## LAUREL LAKE ASSOCIATION NEWS

We are pleased to announce that the Laurel Lake Association and the Town of Fitzwilliam have received a grant from EPA's Clean Water Act via NH Dept. of Environmental Services to develop a watershed protection plan for Laurel Lake! Former resident & LLA Board member Barbara Green has driven the grant proposal for the past 3 years and it was finally approved by the Governor & Executive Council in December.

NH's Southwest Region Planning Commission will administer the grant and perform most of the work which involves evaluating the physical area around the lake, identifying sources of potential or current runoff which can negatively impact the quality of the lake's water and wildlife and developing a plan to mitigate those problem areas. Work will be starting shortly on this.

The Association, its members and the Town actively worked on 3 major projects in 2023 and 2024 to fix sources of runoff pollution into the lake and this grant allows us to look beyond the obvious to identify other risk areas. Laurel Lake's water quality is above average for the state and these grants have typically gone to lakes/ponds which have serious issues.

NHDES now allocates some funding to those lakes with good water quality in order to ensure they stay that way. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to get help in maintaining and improving our beautiful lake. Your membership in the Association and participation in its programs also help with this mission.

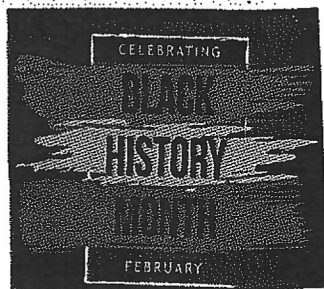

## **SPECIAL BAKED POTATOES**

3 tablespoons mayonnaise

2 cloves garlic, crushed

1 teaspoon dried oregano

salt and pepper to taste

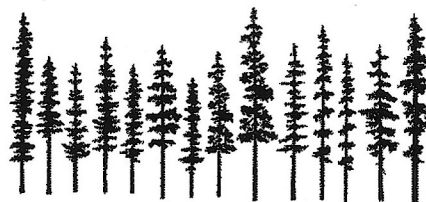
5 potatoes, quartered

In a small bowl, mix mayonnaise, garlic, oregano, salt, and pepper. Set aside.

Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add potatoes, and cook until almost done, about 10 minutes. Don't overcook otherwise the potatoes will break apart. Drain, and cool.

Preheat oven broiler. Line a baking tray with aluminum foil, and lightly grease the aluminum foil.

Arrange potatoes in the prepared baking tray. Spoon the mayonnaise mixture over the potatoes. Place on the prepared grill, and cook until potatoes are tender and mayonnaise mixture is lightly browned, about 10 minutes.

**BROCCOLI CHEESE SOUP**

¾ cup butter  
 ¾ cup all-purpose flour  
 9 cups chicken stock  
 9 cups milk  
 1 teaspoon salt  
 1 ½ teaspoons white pepper  
 5 cups fresh broccoli florets  
 1 ½ pounds processed cheese, shredded  
 3 cups shredded Cheddar cheese

Melt the butter in a large pot over medium heat, and mix in the flour. Reduce heat to low, and cook, stirring constantly, about 2 minutes. Mix in the chicken stock and milk, and season with salt and white pepper. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to low, and simmer about 10 minutes.

Bring a pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Place the broccoli in the boiling water, and cook 2 minutes, or until just tender. Remove from heat, drain, and set aside.

Gradually mix the processed cheese and Cheddar cheese into the large pot until melted. Mix in the broccoli. Continue cooking about 5 minutes.

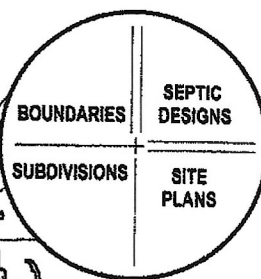
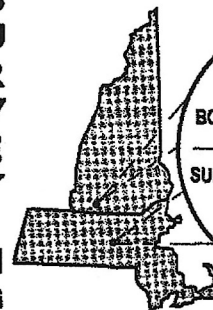

**DOWN EAST CLAM CHOWDER**

4 dozen hard-shell clams, scrubbed, or 1 quart  
shucked cooked clams with their broth  
1/4 pound cubed salt pork or 6 slices bacon  
1 onion, coarsely chopped  
6 medium potatoes, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch  
cubes  
2 cups milk  
2 cups half-and-half or evaporated milk  
6 tablespoons (3/4 stick) unsalted butter  
salt  
freshly ground pepper

Pour clams into a large pot with 1 cup water.  
Cover, bring to a boil, and cook until shells  
open, about 10 minutes. Allow to cool, then  
shuck clams and set aside. Pour off broth and  
reserve, taking care not to disturb any sediment  
in the bottom of the pan.

Cook salt pork in a large saucepan over medium  
heat until the fat runs. Add onion and cook,  
stirring, until tender. Pour off half the fat.

Add potatoes to the pan and stir well. Add clam  
broth and just enough water to cover the  
potatoes. Simmer until potatoes are tender.

Add milk and half-and-half; bring to a simmer.  
Add clams and butter; simmer a few minutes  
until clams are heated through and butter is  
melted. (Do not boil or clams will be tough.)  
Season with salt and pepper.

## **OATMEAL CHOCOLATE CHIP CAKE**

1-3/4 cups boiling water  
1 cup old-fashioned oats  
1/2 cup (1 stick) butter or margarine  
1 cup brown sugar  
1 cup granulated sugar  
2 eggs  
1-3/4 cups sifted all-purpose flour  
1 tablespoon unsweetened cocoa powder  
1 teaspoon baking soda  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 package (12 ounces) semisweet chocolate chips  
3/4 cup chopped nuts (optional)

Preheat oven to 350°F. Lightly grease a 9x13-inch baking dish.

In a bowl, pour boiling water over oats and let stand for 10 minutes. Add butter and stir until melted. Add sugars and eggs and stir until well combined.

In a separate bowl, sift together flour, cocoa powder, baking soda, and salt. Add to oat mixture and mix well. Pour into baking pan and sprinkle with chocolate chips and nuts, if using. Bake for 45 to 55 minutes. Cool completely before serving.

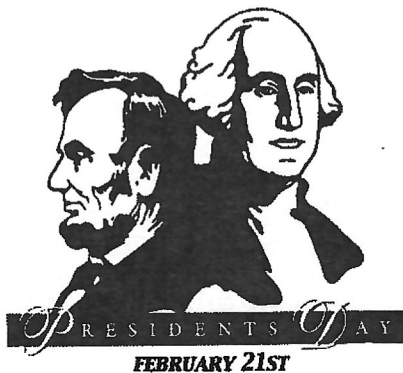

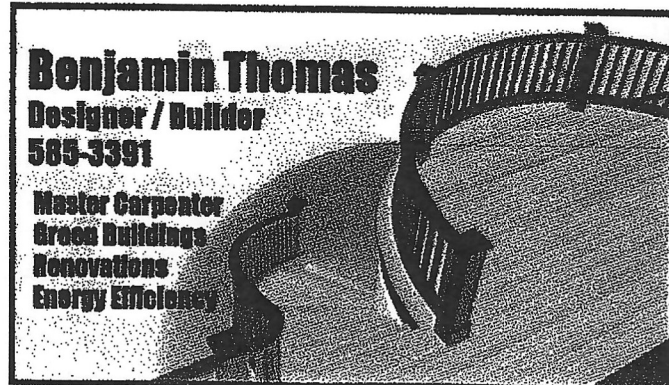

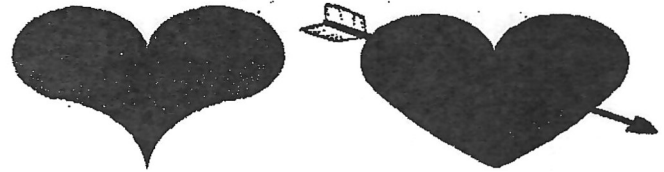
