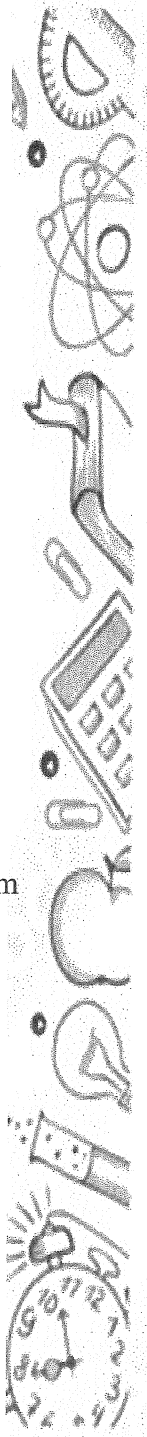

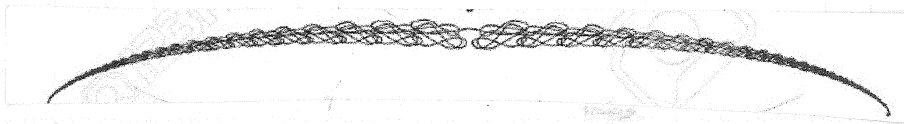
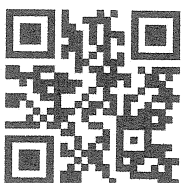

FROM THE SELECTMEN'S OFFICE**PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING STONE POND DAM PROJECT**

We have been working on a joint project with the Connecticut River Conservancy for a dam removal and culvert crossing at the Stone Pond Dam site on Templeton Turnpike. A Public Informational Meeting will be held on August 27th at 6:00 pm during our scheduled meeting at the Fitzwilliam Town Hall, 13 Templeton Turnpike. The purpose of this meeting is to invite appropriate parties including the general public, affected property owners, local officials, and other appropriate parties to discuss the project details.

The fact that we do not feel that we are at significant risk is a testament to the excellent job they are doing. Our officers are an integral part of our community. While patrolling our roads is one of the most visible duties of the department, our officers are faced with numerous tasks daily. The Town of Fitzwilliam has 48.6 miles of paved and gravel roads. It would be impossible for every resident to visibly pass an officer on all the roads on any given day.

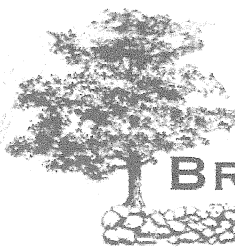

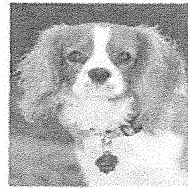

RASPBERRY LEMONADE ICE POPS

1 container (6 oz) raspberry lemonade yogurt
 ½ cup frozen raspberries
 6 paper cups (5-oz size)
 2 containers (6 oz each) vanilla yogurt
 6 flat wooden sticks with round ends

In blender, place raspberry lemonade yogurt and frozen raspberries. Cover; blend on medium speed until smooth.

Divide raspberry mixture evenly among paper cups. Top with vanilla yogurt. Place cups in freezer about 20 minutes or until partially frozen. Insert 1 stick in each cup. Freeze 1 1/2 to 2 hours longer or until completely frozen.

To eat, peel off paper cups.

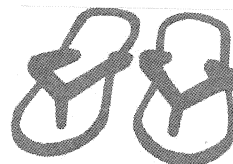

August will be the last month to license your dog(s) before Civil Forfeitures are assigned. Thank you to all those who have licensed their dog(s) to date (have over 500 dogs). Please license them before Sept. 1 to avoid the \$50.00 Civil Forfeiture fee.

We are busy with registrations (vehicle and boat) as well as all the rest that we do in the office. Just a friendly reminder: Please bring your registration certificate with you when renewing. We are supposed to charge you for a duplicate (\$18.00) if you do not have it. Don't hate us; it's a State regulation. A lot of things have changed when processing your registrations. Please be aware of this when you come in.

Fitzwilliam is still a 2 check Town. When paying your registration fee we need 2 checks: one to the Town of Fitzwilliam and one to the State of NH.

Enjoy the last of the summer weather! The Town Clerk's office will be CLOSED Sept. 1 in observance of Labor Day. Regular hours will resume Tuesday, Sept. 2.

FRESH PEACH CRUMBLE

2-3 cups peach slices
 1 teaspoon lemon juice
 1 cup all purpose flour
 ¾ cup brown sugar (packed)
 1 pinch salt
 ¼ cup butter salted (softened)

Pre-heat oven to 350F / 180C. Grease and flour an 8 inch square pan.

Arrange the peach slices in the pan. Drizzle the lemon juice over the slices.

In a medium bowl whisk the flour, brown sugar and salt, cut in the butter to form coarse crumbs. Sprinkle the crumb mixture over the peaches. Bake for 25-30 minutes or until golden brown on top. Let cool to warm, then serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream if desired.

(If using canned peaches, drain them well)



STRAWBERRY MOUSSE

12 1/2 ounces strawberries (3/4 pound)
1/2 cup granulated sugar
1 cup whole or whipping cream (cold)
extra strawberries for topping

Clean and slice the strawberries, In a blender or food processor add the sliced strawberries and the sugar and puree. Remove 1/2 a cup of puree and set aside.

In a cold bowl add the cream and beat until stiff peaks form. Then fold in the remaining puree (not the 1/2 cup) gently.

Divide the 1/2 cup of puree between the 4 small/medium** glasses and top with the strawberry mousse. Refrigerate for approximately 1 hour or even over night if desired. Top with fresh sliced strawberries and serve.

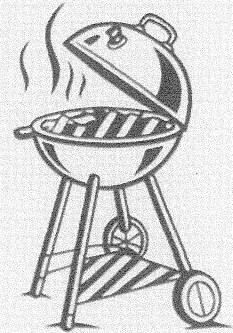

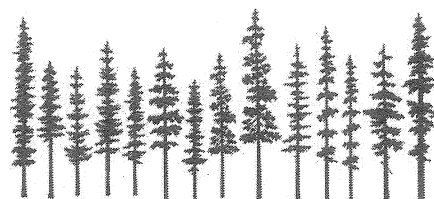
